

Gloria DeJesus April 24, 1948 - April 9, 2021

Gloria DeJesus, daughter of the late Benigno Sanchez and Julia Torres, was born Saturday, April 24, 1948, in Villalba, Puerto Rico.

A pioneer for many years and a servant of Jehovah God, Gloria attended Gibson Street Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses, Harrisburg, PA. She retired from Strites Orchard, Harrisburg, after more than forty years of service.
