



Adolphus Weems Jr.

July 13, 1948 - September 16, 2025

Adolphus Weems, Jr., son of the late Adolphus Weems, Sr. and Katie (Johnson) Weems, was born on Tuesday, July 13, 1948, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

He received his education in the Steelton School District and graduated from John Harris High School. As a young man, he loved basketball, a passion that earned him the nickname "Mouse." In his leisure, he enjoyed dancing, car detailing, dressing sharply, and following the latest fashions—always carrying himself with style and grace.

On February 18, 1975, Adolphus was drafted into the United States Army, where he faithfully served his country during the Vietnam War. His dedication and service earned him numerous honors, including the National Defense Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Overseas Bar, Vietnam Service Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal with 60 Device, Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry with Palm (Unit), Expert Qualification Badge with #26 Rifle Bar, and the Sharpshooter Qualification with Rifle Bar. His bravery and sacrifice reflected his strength of character and commitment to duty.

Adolphus was a member of Martin Luther King Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor James E. Golden. His faith was a steady foundation in his life.

On Tuesday, September 16, 2025, Adolphus Weems, Jr. peacefully departed this life at seventy-seven years of age. He was preceded in death by his parents, Adolphus Weems, Sr., and Katie Weems; his son, Corey M. Weems; and his brother, Stephen L. Weems.

His legacy lives on through his children, Valerie Regina Buxton Punch (Kerwin) and Adolphus Weems III (Kristine); his siblings, James W. Weems Sr. (Linda), Nathaniel Weems, Sr. (the late Victoria), Regina Alridge, Valerie A. Brown (Garnell), and Malcom Weems. He also leaves to cherish his memory two grandchildren, one great-grandchild, and a host of nieces, nephews, extended family, and friends.
