



Rev. Alex Erby Jr.

November 16, 1950 - December 10, 2025

Reverend Alex Erby Jr., son of the late Alex Erby Sr. and Johnie Mae (Edwards) Erby, was born on Thursday, November 16, 1950, in Steelton, Pennsylvania.

Alex was a proud graduate of Steelton Highspire High School. He later furthered his studies by attending Bethune-Cookman University in Daytona Beach, Florida. He then began a long and dedicated career with PP&L in Harrisburg, PA, from which he retired after many years of faithful service.

Affectionately called “Pop Pop,” Reverend Erby lived a life of faith, family, fellowship, and community. A respected Reverend, he touched countless lives through his guidance, encouragement, and the genuine care he showed to everyone he encountered. He was known for his warm spirit and outgoing nature, never passing by without a greeting, and for the sense of belonging he brought wherever he went.

Alex was a lifelong pillar of the Steelton community and a devoted supporter of the Steelton Highspire School District. For more than 50 years, he could be found on the sidelines or in the stands, proudly cheering on the Rollers at athletic events. His passion for sports, especially Roller athletics, was unmatched, and his presence was a constant source of encouragement for student-athletes. His signature smile and unwavering support became a

familiar and cherished part of the community.

Above all else, Alex was a devoted father and a fiercely proud grandfather. He rarely missed a game or event, ensuring his children and grandchildren always felt his unwavering support. His love for family, sports, and community defined his life and legacy.

On Wednesday, December 10, 2025, at the age of seventy-five, Reverend Alex Erby Jr. peacefully transitioned into eternal rest at UPMC Harrisburg Hospital. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Joan Brown.

He leaves to honor and cherish his life, his sons, Brian Erby and Andrew Erby (Tara); his daughter, Leigh Ann Erby; his grandchildren, Courtney Erby, Alex Erby III, Andrew Erby Jr., Kennedy Erby, Alexa Erby, Bryat Erby, and Mia Erby; three great-grandchildren; his niece, Elizabeth "Buffy" Pettis; his nephews, Jeremy Ross and Chris Brown; and a host of extended family members, friends, athletes, and community members who loved and respected him dearly.
