Allen Mosten, known as 'Moss,' and 'Big Al,' was born Thursday, February 1, 1940, in McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania, son of the late David Lane and Cora Mosten.

He received his formal education in the Harrisburg Public School System and graduated from William Penn High School, Class of 1959. After graduating from high school, Allen attended Bloomsburg University on a football scholarship. Allen retired from Mobil Oil Corporation in 2000 as a plant operator and truck driver. He was a faithful member of the John Paul Scott Community Church where he served on the Men's Usher Board.

Allen enjoyed helping others, listening to music, staying in contact with friends, spending quality time with his family, watching sports, and, most of all, spending endless hours with his beloved granddaughter Diana, who affectionately called him "Nonno." Allen loved people and people loved Allen
