Anna, the youngest and last survivor of seven siblings, was born in Steelton, PA, on Saturday, September 17, 1927, to the late Charles and Mary Stannard.

Anna began her education at the former Hygienic School and graduated from Steelton High School.

Having accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior, Anna became a member of Mount Zion Missionary Baptist Church as a young child.
