July 18, 1942 - September 11, 2025

Annie Mae Gray, daughter of the late Herndon Eugene Gray and the late Irene (Pendelton) Gray, was born on Saturday, July 18, 1942, in Amissville, VA.

In 1972, Annie relocated from Virginia to Harrisburg, PA, where she began a career with the Harrisburg School District. Over the span of 31 years, she worked faithfully in food service, beginning at Hamilton School. She later became a manager and continued at the old middle school until its closing, and finally at William Penn High School until her retirement.

Annie was a devoted member of Unity Temple #61, where she served as Treasurer, Past State President, Past Grand Member of the Education Department, a member of the Shrine Department, and Assistant Financial Secretary. She also was a member of the Turtle Club, through these roles, she built lasting friendships and earned respect for her dedication and leadership.
