Elder Annie Mae Harris Banks was born Tuesday, August 13, 1918, in Hogansville, Georgia.

Annie received her formal education in the Hogansville, GA, Public Schools. In 1935, she relocated to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. She married George G. Banks Sr. who preceded her in death. This union was blessed with three sons.

Elder Banks' employment history spanned over twenty-five years with the Harrisburg Hospital, Housekeeping Department.

Having accepted Christ as her personal Savior many years ago, she was united in Christian fellowship with XII Stones Church of God In Christ under the pastorate of Supt. Wilson Mosley Jr., and she was formerly a member of Mt. Calvary Church of God In Christ for several years. Elder Banks' missionary, fundraising and outreach service to her church as well as churches in the community assisted in the fruition of many projects. She was well known for her delicious cakes, pies and cookies fundraising efforts.

At her home in Harrisburg, PA, on Monday, July 24, 2017, at the blessed age of ninety-eight, Elder Annie Mae Banks triumphantly transitioned from time to eternity joining in eternal life her husband, George Banks, son, Kenneth Banks, and sister, Tila Mae Hunter.
