Annie Lee Dunston Perry was born on September 9, 1928 in Franklinton, North Carolina, to the late Percy Dunston and Fannie Griffin Dunston.

At an early age, Annie accepted Christ and joined the United Christian Church where she attended until she graduated from Albion Academy, Franklinton, North Carolina. After graduation, she relocated to Stamford, Connecticut, and to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

She was employed by Pennsylvania's Air Filter Manufacturing where she retired after thirty years of service.

After retirement, Annie enjoyed volunteering at the "Uptown Senior Center," which in 1992 became the Heinz-Menaker Senior Center.
