February 20, 1930 - December 24, 2021

Ardelia Washington, affectionately known as "Sis" by family and friends, was born Thursday, February 20, 1930, in Steelton, PA, daughter of the late William Wallace and the late Lula (Pinkney) Brown.

A product of the Steelton School District, Sis retired from the Commonwealth of PA.
