Barbara Jean Howard-Hinton, daughter of the late Leroy Howard Sr. and the late Ella (Bradley) Howard, was born Sunday, September 13, 1953, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

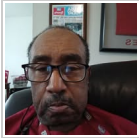

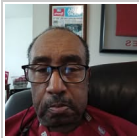

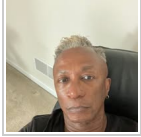
