Ben Dixon, son of Walter Dixon Jr. and Maggie Peterson, was born Tuesday, January 27, 1948, in Bishopville, South Carolina.

Ben graduated from Dennis High School in South Carolina and, thereafter, enlisted and served honorably in the United States Army. He was united in Christian fellowship with Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, Harrisburg, PA, where he served with the Trustee Ministry. Ben retired from Reckitt Benckiser and was content shooting pool, playing cards, cruising around town and simply hanging out with friends at McDonald's.
