



Brandon J. Flood

July 22, 1982 - August 24, 2025

Brandon J. Flood, son of the late Kenneth Stone and the late Debra Flood, was born on Thursday, July 22, 1982, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Brandon graduated from Harrisburg High School and from an early age demonstrated both a sharp intellect and a passion for service. As a champion for Justice, his professional journey reflected his steadfast commitment to public service, criminal justice reform, and second chances for those seeking to rebuild their lives.

Brandon's career path included serving as Deputy Director for Government Affairs at Ceasefire PA, Associate Director of Workforce Development at Eastern State Penitentiary, Executive Director for SEIU and Pennsylvania Legislative Black Caucus. In 2019, he was appointed Secretary of the Pennsylvania Board of Pardons, where he made history as a formerly incarcerated individual leading one of the Commonwealth's most powerful offices of mercy. He served in that role until 2022.

Beyond his government service, Brandon's vision for empowering others continued through entrepreneurship and nonprofit leadership. He was the Founder of Lazarus Firm LLC and served as Founding Board President of Bro2Go Inc., a nonprofit dedicated to strengthening re-entry programming and providing mentorship for returning citizens. Brandon earned recognition at the local, county, and state levels for his unwavering commitment to second chances, social justice, and equity.

On Sunday, August 24, 2025, Brandon J. Flood departed this life in

Philadelphia, PA, at forty-three years of age. Along with his parents, Brandon was preceded in death by many who paved the way before him.

Brandon leaves behind a legacy of purpose and impact, which will be carried forward by his sons: Nolan X. Adams, Tristan B. Flood, and Mason S. Flood; sisters, Brandi Stone and Natasha Stone; as well as his extended family, colleagues, mentees, and countless friends across Pennsylvania and beyond who were touched by his advocacy, wisdom, and generosity of spirit.

Brandon's life was a testament to the power of redemption, resilience, and service, and his influence will endure through the countless lives he uplifted.

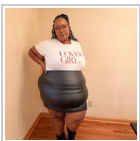

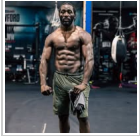
