Calvin B. Lawrence was born Friday, March 8, 1940, in Franklin,
Pennsylvania, son of Mr. Vivian Lawrence and Mrs. Evelyn McCain Lawrence.

Upon his high school graduation, Calvin later matriculated to Shaw University, Raleigh, North Carolina, where he earned his college degree. He served his country honorably in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and was the recipient of numerous medals to include the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry W/Palm Medal and the Army Aviation Badge. After many years of dedicated service, Calvin retired from the United States Army/Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington, DC.

He was united in Christian fellowship with the Erie Street Church of God in Christ, Franklin, PA. His family, especially his grandchildren, watching football, working out, traveling and helping others by providing transportation and in whatever other ways he could were his life passions.
