



## Rev. Dr. Carl L. Carelock

Rev. Dr. Carl L. Carelock, 67, went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Thursday, November 3, 2016, surrounded by his loving family. He was born February 3, 1949 in Harrisburg, PA, to Lucius Durant and Wydantha Bumbrey. A native of Steelton, PA, he graduated from the former William Penn High School, Class of 1967. He enlisted in the United States Air Force where he continued his education and graduated with a dual degree.
