A graduate of Freedom High School in Bethlehem, PA, Dr. Cathy received her Bachelor's Degree and Master's in Human Services from Lincoln University, Philadelphia, PA. She also received a Master's in Biblical Studies at Lancaster Bible College and a Doctorate of Marriage and Family Therapy at Eastern University, St. Davids, PA.

Dr. Cathy, together with her husband Pastor Duane Coleman, provided pastoral, spiritual leadership, guidance and teaching at Agape International Family Worship Center in Harrisburg, PA.

Dr. Cathy was a warm, loving "Lady of God" with a smile embracing everyone she met. Among her many interests were traveling and adventure, singing karaoke and her family. A passionate professional, Dr. Cathy helped others navigate through the challenges and transitions of life. 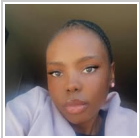
