Charles, known as ‘Chippy’ by family and friends, was born Saturday, January 11, 1964, in Chambersburg, PA, son of Shianne Jones Johnson and the late Charles Edward Johnson Sr.

Chippy began his formal education at Falling Spring Elementary School, Chambersburg, and graduated from John Harris High School, Class of 1982, Harrisburg, PA. Thereafter, from 1983 through 1984, he received further educational training at Hiram Andrews, Pittsburgh, PA.

Chippy was a second generation member of Emanuel Church of God In Christ under the leadership of Bishop David M. Screven. Having been baptized in October, 2010, he was faithful in church and Sunday School, and he attended the National A.I.M. Convention. His church affiliations also included Unity Praise Temple from 2015 through 2017 under the leadership of Bishop C. L. Lancaster. There, he served with the Usher Board and as Parking Attendant. Chippy enjoyed WWE Wrestling, especially Rock/Hulk. At the age of fifty-four, Charles Edward Johnson Jr. transitioned into eternal life on Monday, April 23, 2018, while at the Chambersburg Hospital.
