Charles Edward Robinson, son of the late Henry Charles Robinson and Caroline Robinson, was born Tuesday, December 8, 1953, in Front Royal, VA.

Affectionately known as “Bud” by family and friends, Charles graduated from Johnson-Williams High School in Berryville, VA, and attended Randolph Academy in Fort Royal, VA. Thereafter, he enlisted in the United States Army where he served as Staff Sergeant and Supply Specialist receiving numerous certificates, awards and medals during his eight-year tour of duty.

Charles retired as a Computer Programmer Supervisor from the Department of Public Welfare after thirty-two years of dedicated service. He was also a Legionnaire member at Post 733.
