Conlan was born May 25, 1962, in Harrisburg, PA, the sixth child of the late David L. Archer Sr. and Bernice (Mitchner) Archer. He was educated in the Harrisburg Public School System and graduated in 1980 from Harrisburg High School.

Conlan was employed in the security field at various organizations during his lifetime. He was very well-known; and as he moved throughout his community, he touched almost everyone.

Though he had a quiet soul, he had a roaring spirit for the Lord. He accepted the Lord as his personal savior in 1991 and was baptized at The Greater Zion Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Charles R. Meile Jr. He was currently a member of Trinity Church of God under the pastorate of Rev. Walter R. 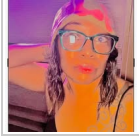
