Curtis Bishop Tomlinson, son of the late Willie B. Tomlinson Sr. and the late Nannie Pearl (Poole) Tomlinson, was born Sunday, June 25, 1950, in Somerville R3, Tennessee.

Curtis graduated from William Penn High School, Harrisburg, PA, where he participated in track and field. After his retirement as Chef from Denny's Restaurant, Curtis continued his passion of daily running and riding his bike around Harrisburg. Known for his offbeat sense of humor, Curtis was someone you could rely on at any given time or on any given day. He loved his best friend and companion, his dog "Blackey," as well as his LP oldies vinyl records and watching his movies on VHS tapes still utilizing the VCR.
