David Robinson, affectionately known as "Pork Chops," by family and friends, was born Saturday, May 28, 1921, in Montezuma, GA, son of the late Henry and Hannah (Haugebrook) Robinson.

In 1940, he relocated to Harrisburg, PA. Pork Chops served in the United States Army during World War II. After forty-two years of dedicated service, he retired from Harrisburg Steel. He was an amateur boxer, baseball player and bull rider.
