David, affectionately known as 'Yohman' by family and friends, was born August 19, 1952, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.



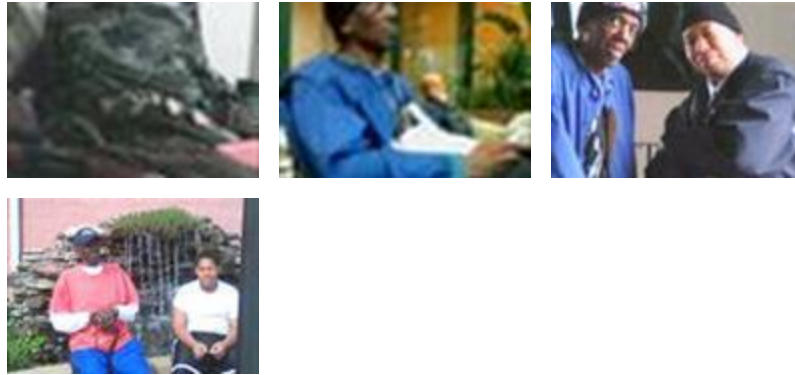
