In the fall of 1988, Dawn married Booker Fulmore Jr. and moved to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, where their relationship and faith in God grew stronger over the next thirty-two years. There, Dawn and her family attended Life Center Ministries for many years under Pastor Charles Stock and later grew their faith with members of the Living Water Community Church family under Pastor Mike Leonzo.

Dawn was an easy person to love. She was a genuine, sweet, kind and gentle person who was a loving wife, mother, sister and loyal friend to those in her circle. She enjoyed reading, musicals, playing games and small intimate gatherings among family and friends. Dawn was not one for confrontation and would always try to play the role of peacemaker. But, when it came to playing

And, she really enjoyed playing scratch-off tickets she would occasionally buy and especially those she received as gifts on holidays and her birthday.

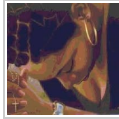
