Elizabeth Louise Perry, 76, of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, passed away peacefully at home on December 15, 2022. Elizabeth, affectionately known as Betty, was born December 11, 1946 to William and Alice Hunter in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. After Elizabeth graduated from William Penn High School in 1964, she went on to study at Central Penn College.
