He received his formal education at Bishop McDevitt High School. Having a desire to further his education, he attended Harrisburg Area Community College and Central Penn Community College.

Ellis was raised in Gospel Tabernacle Church of God in Christ and Word Fellowship Church. In later years, he rededicated his life to Christ and united with the Mount Olive Baptist Church.

His working career included Supply Clerk, New Cumberland Army Depot, Defense Distribution Center, Susquehanna, Pennsylvania.

Man/E40, as he was affectionately called, loved his family and people in general. He was very friendly and would start a conversation with strangers and talk to them as if they were his best friends. 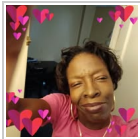
