June 28, 1969 - July 30, 2024

Erick Torain, a devoted husband, loving father, and esteemed businessman, passed away at his home in Swedesboro, New Jersey, on July 30, 2024. Born in Baltimore, Maryland, on June 28, 1969, Erick was the youngest of two children and graduated from Bishop McDevitt High School in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, in 1987. He went on to earn his bachelor's degree in economics from Lehigh University, where he distinguished himself as a talented running back for the university's football team.

Erick's greatest pride and joy was his family. He married his beloved wife, Thewantha (Hines) Torain, on June 25, 1994, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. Their 30-year union was a testament to their deep love and partnership, and his devotion as a "Girl Dad" to his three daughters, Nadia, Peyton, and Kennedy. Erick was known for his boundless affection and unwavering support. Erick was also a cherished uncle to his nieces and nephews, particularly his goddaughter and niece, Zalaya Graves.

Erick's professional journey was marked by remarkable achievements and leadership. Before founding his own companies, he built an impressive career in finance, holding positions at RBC Capital Markets, First Albany Corp., MR Beal & Company, and Public Financial Management. In 2011, Erick established the Torain Group, LLC, along with Torain Construction, Inc., and The Penake Group, LLC. Through these ventures, he successfully facilitated

over \$50 million in financings for New Jersey Charter Schools, non-profits, and for-profit organizations, reflecting his commitment to community and education.

An avid Tampa Bay Buccaneers fan, Erick enjoyed watching football, traveling, reading history, and engaging in spirited debates. His zest for life and his generous spirit endeared him to all who knew him.

Erick was preceded in death by his mother, Nannie Elaine Torain. He is survived by his devoted wife, Thewantha Torain of Swedesboro, New Jersey; three daughters, Nadia Shirk (and son-in-law Toren) of Missoula, Montana, Peyton Torain of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and Kennedy Torain of New York City, New York; his father, Ernest Torain Sr. of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania; his brother, Ernest Torain Jr. (and sister-in-law Karin and their sons, Trey Torain and Ethan Torain) of Evanston, Illinois; and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, sisters-in-law and brothers-in-law.
