Esther Lee Davis, daughter of the late George W. Davis II and Annie Laura (Johnson) Davis, was born on Wednesday, November 4, 1936, in Sandersville, Georgia.

She received her formal education in the Steelton-Highspire School District and graduated from Steelton Highspire High School, Class of 1955. She later built a steady and committed career with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, retiring from the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare after twenty-nine years of dedicated service.
