Evon Marlece Wright Floyd was born on June 16, 1942 in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. She was the daughter of the late Ralph and Mathelder T. Wright. Evon grew up on the 500 block of Lincoln Street in Steelton and was educated in the Steelton-Highspire School system.

On December 12th 1959, she married Lester L. Wigington, of this union she had 4 children: Lester Michael Wigington, Byron Keith Wigington, Denise Evette Foskey (Isiah) and Kelly Lenora Jones (James).

On August 6, 1977, she was united in marriage to Roosevelt Floyd. Evon was a devoted and loving wife to Roosevelt for 37 years.

Evon was predeceased by her son, Byron Keith, her parents, two brothers, Ralph Orville and Robert Lloyd, and two sisters, Maxine and Juanita.

Evon leaves to cherish her memories three sisters, Landonia O. Vaughan, Lucille A. Ray of Steelton and Althea O. Manning; three brothers, Alton A. Wright, Kenneth E. Wright of Harrisburg, William A. Wright of Steelton; and an aunt, Jane Phillips of Steelton.

Evon worked at Hershey Creamery for 9 years. She also worked at the former Amp Incorporated, and retired after 25 years of service in 1998. She retired from the Commonwealth of PA, the Department of Revenue, with 14 years of service in 2013.

Evon was a devoted member of The First Baptist Church of Steelton, for more than 60 years, where she served on the Senior Usher Board since 1971. She

loved to usher. Evon also was a member of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Trustees and served as President.

She was a member of The Order of Eastern Star, Esther Chapter No. 1, since December 1998. In June 2010, Evon was elected Worthy Matron of Esther Chapter No. 1 until June of 2011.

Evon was appointed, by Grand Worthy Matron, Janice C. Harvey, as District Deputy Grand Matron from 2012 until 2014.

Evon also was a member of Order of The Golden Circle Harrisburg Assembly No. 50, since June 2000 was a Past Loyal Lady Ruler of Harrisburg Assembly No. 50, and served as Secretary of the Assembly.

On May 21, 2015, she was called home to be with the Lord and her mother and father, son, brothers, and sisters.
