



Florence B. (Pittman) Frazier

September 6, 1940 - January 21, 2024

Florence B. Pittman Frazier was born in Altoona, Pennsylvania on September 6, 1940. She was the second of four children born to the late Milford M. Pittman, Sr. and Bertha V. Johnson Pittman. She was a 1958 graduate of Altoona High School and a 1961 graduate of Altoona Hospital School of Nursing. She retired after 38 years of Psychiatric Nursing as an employee of the Pennsylvania Department of Public Works. She worked five years at the former Hollidaysburg State Hospital and 33 years at the former Harrisburg State Hospital.

Florence was a founding member of The Rose of Sharon Baptist Church. There she served in the following ministries: Nurses Unit, Christian Women United, Adult Choir Director, Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and the Trustees. In the community she was a member of the Capital Area Music Association, the Florettes Bowling League, and the Steelton Senior Center. She was an avid fan of the Pittsburgh Steelers and the Steel-High Rollers football and basketball teams. She also enjoyed crocheting, knitting, cross-stitch, crewel embroidery, and computer card games.

She was preceded in death by her brother Milford M. Pittman, Jr. and her sister Daisy L. Pittman. Surviving are a son, Jeffrey S. Pittman (Steelton, PA); a daughter, Virginia E.L. Frazier (Jessup, MD); a sister, Nancy E. Pittman (Oakland, CA); two nieces, Rhonda Hart (Oakland, CA), and Brenda John

(Martin) (Harrisburg, PA); a nephew, M. Maurice Pittman (Houston, TX); 5 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.

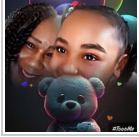
