November 29, 1920 - November 20, 2023

Florence Geneva Mosby, the youngest daughter of 5 children of the late Patrick C. and Emily V. Christian Hill, was born on November 29, 1920, in Nelson County, Virginia.

In her Steelton, PA home on Monday, November 20, 2023, at the age of 102, Florence G. Mosby's spirit was blessed to depart her earthly vessel and entered Heaven, which she desired with her whole heart.

She graduated from Steelton High School, Class of 1939, with the "scientific" class designation. After a dedicated career, she retired from the Commonwealth of PA, Department of Labor & Industry.

Florence was married to Samuel Robinson, Jr. for 49 years and in this marriage was blessed with 6 children: Patricia D. Roberts of Las Vegas, NV, Samuel "Colyan" Robinson, III of Harrisburg PA, William S. Robinson of Albany, NY, Elder Elaine "Tootsie" Kershaw, Dennis "Jackie" Robinson (Thomastine) and Terry L. Robinson, all of Steelton, PA.

In 1994 at the age of 72, Florence fell in love with Deacon James A. Mosby, Sr. and in this 17-year marriage was blessed with 10 "gift" children: Yvonne Harvey, James A. Mosby, Jr. (Lois), Theresa Chisholm, Joyce Spivey, Carolyn Selvey (Samuel), Marilyn "Gail" Hughes (Jairus), G. Wayne Mosby (Denise),

all of Harrisburg, PA, Elwood Miller (Dell) of New Rochelle, NY, Charles Mosby (Carmen) of Mitchellville, MD, and Leon Mosby (Dorothy) of Montgomery, AL.

In addition to her parents, Florence was preceded in death by husbands, Samuel Robinson, Jr. and Deacon James A. Mosby, Sr.; her children, Elder Elaine V. Kershaw, Samuel M. Robinson, III, Dennis J. Robinson and Yvonne Harvey; her siblings, Mabel V. Gholston, Walter C. Hill, Preston F. Hill and Henry J. Hill, Sr.; and her best friend, Etta Payne.

Florence's early Christian life began with Mt. Zion Baptist Church, where she worshipped with her family. After marriage, she became a member of Monumental AME Church, uniting with her husband Sam in 1960 under the pastorate of Rev. Gabriel Hardeman and has been a faithful member for over 70 years. She is considered an Emeritus Member of the Hazel Floyd Stewardess Board, Missionary Board, Lay Organization, Young People's Department, the Senior Choir and the Combined Choir.

She instilled in her family the love of God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. To treat all people with respect. To walk with pride yet embrace humility. Her constant reminder to family and friends was to take "one day at a time."

Sister Florence held title of Past Worthy Matron and was a proud member of Sheba Chapter No. 32, OESPHA. She served for over 25 years in the capacity of recording secretary.

Florence enjoyed fellowship each Tuesday with The First Baptist Church Senior Citizens and in her community, the Steelton Senior Citizens Guild. She found pleasure in arts and crafts, painting, crocheting, daily reading, cryptograms, crossword puzzles and playing scrabble with Deacon Mosby after the dinner hour.

She loved house plants, creating flower gardens, and had an excellent green thumb, excelling in growing African Violets. Her love of cooking family meals was only outmatched by her desire to bake Christmas cookies, pound cakes and her “famous” apple pie.

She was a big sports fan, and in the 1960s, 1970s, she enjoyed the Steel-High Rollers, along with her brothers and children. Her favorite professional teams were the Philadelphia Eagles, Phillies and the 76ers.

She was adored by her many grandchildren, great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.

Her affectionate words that were said in farewell were, “I love you a bushel and a peck and a hug around the neck.” These words will always be cherished.
