George O. Eubanks, son of the late William H. Dade and the late Essie (Miller) Larks, was born Friday, July 14, 1950, in Harrisburg, PA, the seventh of fourteen children.

George's mother and father ensured that their children would have a strong foundation in Christ from an early age. George began his Christian life at Tabernacle Baptist Church, Harrisburg, PA. He faithfully participated in the activities of the church including church trips, Sunday School and the choir. George was a humble and generous person who exemplified pride, grace, humility and the true meaning of family, especially when it came to his daughter Cherrie, his grandchildren, Shaquille, Lameak and Larea, and two little girls he loved as his own, Marleigh and Marlowe, and the love-of-his-life, his best friend and companion Gloria who shared with him many years of good times; she was his rock.

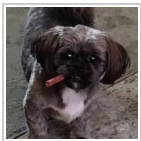
