George Harvey, known as "Noot" by family and friends, was born Friday, September 10, 1937, in Orangeburg County, SC, son of the late Julius Harvey Sr. and Eliza (Pelzer) Harvey.

George received his formal education in the Orangeburg County School System. In the 1950's, he moved to Harrisburg, PA, where he met the love-of-his-life, Elease Kennerly who became his loving wife of sixty-three years.
