



Hattie Mack Chisholm

September 24, 1930 - January 16, 2024

Hattie Mack Chisholm, daughter of the late Charles Wallington and the late Annie Murphy Wallington, was born Wednesday, September 24, 1930, in Fairfield, South Carolina. She received her formal education at Sims High School, Union, SC.

At sixteen years of age, Hattie was baptized at Antioch Baptist Church. By Christian experience, she united with Mount Zion Missionary Baptist Church, Steelton, PA, on December 11, 1983, with a handful of fellowship on January 1, 1984.

Hattie's employment history included twenty years of service at the Harrisburg Hospital and retirement from Dauphin Manor Nursing Home with twenty-four years of service. On April 6, 1992, she joined the Order of the Eastern Star where she served for thirty-one years.

While at the Penn State Health Holy Spirit Medical Center, Camp Hill, PA, on Tuesday, January 16, 2024, Hattie Mack Chisholm transitioned from labor to reward at the blessed age of ninety-three joining in eternal life her parents, her spouse, Charles A. Chisholm; sister, Annie B. Staff; and two sons, Charles A. Chisholm and Alphonso A. Chisholm.
