Junior was a quiet, easy-going man who lived life day by day without stress. His foremost joys undoubtedly came from his grandchildren. With each new child brought into his life, he became visibly more passionate, more joyful, more abundant. Shortly before his passing, Junior learned that he had several more grandchildren from his eldest son, and he had reached out to them in order to bring the families together.

Junior was preceded in death by his sons, Aaron and Humberto Jr. Aviles; his mother, Flora Aviles; sister, Rosa Claudio; and brother, Felix Claudio, Jr.
