Ida Belle Penn-Cox, daughter of the late Vester Penn and Laura Finney, and stepdaughter of Minnie Hughes Penn, was born Sunday, November 24, 1918, in Mt. Airy, NC.

She was educated in a one-room school in Surry County, North Carolina. Ida was an exceptional homemaker and a dedicated childcare provider to both family and friends. She also served as a caregiver for her sister-in-law, Cathleen Cox Robinson, for 15 years.

Ida loved to crochet and made afghans for her children, grandchildren, family and friends. She was also an excellent quilter and pillow maker. She baked delicious pound cakes, pies, cookies, homemade rolls and biscuits that were enjoyed by her family and friends.

She was a faithful member of The First Baptist Church of Steelton for over 75 years where she served on the Ladies' Auxiliary to the Trustee Board.

At the age of 101, Ida transitioned into eternal life on Thursday, July 2, 2020, in the comfort of her home surrounded by her family. She was preceded in death by her husband, Payne Nathaniel Cox Sr.; her parents and stepmother; her siblings, Delia, Dovie, Cossie, Foy, Troy, Chester, Versie, Gertrude, Lillie and Lou Ada.
