Born January 16, 1981, to Rafiyqa Muhammad and the late great Abdul Ali Muhammad in Harrisburg, PA. He was the firstborn son of their five children together, Shariyka "Asia," Ishmael, Imhotep and Aliyah. Born into an Islamic household, Unique was homeschooled before attending the private Ngozi Institute of Islamic and Cultural Education. During his childhood, under his father's training, he honed his exceptional martial arts skills, earning a 7th Dan Black Belt in the Universal African Fighting Arts System. He assisted his father as an instructor at Ngozi for many years. Guided by his mother, Unique became a master djembe drummer and performed with the Neema African Dance Company, where his mother taught traditional African dance. He soon got accustomed to being on stage in front of huge audiences as a musical performer and doing martial arts demonstrations for cultural festivals and community events.

In his teenage years, inspired by his cousins, who are members of the famous Wu-Tang Clan, Unique discovered his gift for writing and performing poetic rap lyrics. Influenced by his cousins ODB, RZA and GZA, he traveled across the United States with them as a young adult, developing his skills and creating Secret Society Recordz. He wrote, performed, and produced numerous albums, including “Sharp Lika Sword,” “Method of Supreme Bleszing,” “Unique & Ish Lyrics,” “Fresh Outta Rehab,” and “Unique’s Shattered Dreamz.” These albums have received popularity and acclaim both in the States and in Europe, and his music streams on all major platforms.

After extensive travel Unique returned to Harrisburg, where he dedicated much of his time to his passion for music, recording in the studio and making videos. Many local rap artists collaborated with him, either producing or appearing on his records. He and other members of Secret Society wrote inspiring lyrics for the Harrisburg AIDS Prevention Society using music as an educational tool to inform younger people of the risks.

In 2003, Unique was involved in a serious car accident that resulted in him becoming a quadriplegic. The prognosis was grim—he was not expected to live, and if he did, his life expectancy was only 1 to 3 years in his condition. After a long rehabilitation process, thanks to the grace of the Most High, the unwavering love, prayers, and support from his family, community, and lifelong companion Yvonne Otero, Unique thrived. He lived on for 21 remarkable years, demonstrating a courageous and determined spirit. He became actively involved in creating his caregiving system and became an outspoken advocate for his care. Unique continued attending physical therapy and worked religiously with a personal trainer to maintain his health and fitness. With an undying zest for life, he continued recording music. With a wide fanbase, he conducted media interviews and was featured in an article for Mode Magazine titled "About Being Unique."

Unique became a homeowner in uptown Harrisburg and purchased a customized vehicle for comfortable travel. An entrepreneur at heart, he recently started Ra Da Sunlord Clothing Co. Despite his tough exterior, Unique was a generous and compassionate man. He opened his home to family and friends in need and did his best to be a loving and supportive son, brother, father, grandfather, uncle, and nephew.

Throughout his life, which he miraculously extended, Unique led a meaningful and productive life doing what he loved, surrounded by loved ones and many pets, including turtles, fish, birds, and his beloved cats.
