Deacon James A. Mosby, Sr., of Ridge Street, Steelton, passed from labor to reward on May 18, 2010. He was born May 10, 1919 in Naola, VA, son of the late Edward and Sally Mosby.

He was a World War II Army Veteran and retired from Bethlehem Steel Corporation after 40 years of service. As a member of The First Baptist Church of Steelton for 67 years, he served faithfully as past Chairman of the Trustee and Deacon Ministries, Church Council, Teacher of New Members Class, Member of Missionaries, Charles Donahue Male Chorus, Senior Citizens and Laymen's League Ministries, Trustee of Camp Central Baptist Association and numerous other committees. His civic and community affiliations included NAACP, Borough of Steelton Senior Citizens, Block Captain of Steelton Crime Watch Association, driver and delivery person for Meals on Wheels, and member of the Hygienic No. 7 Fire and Rescue Company.
