Jeries, ‘Jerry’ as she was fondly called, was born Sunday, March 17, 1946, in Beckley, West Virginia, to the late Charles Vernon Mitchell Sr. and the late Martha Dobson.

At the age of sixteen, Jeries came to Harrisburg, PA, to provide health care to a family member.

Jeries was a strong woman and even though she had succumbed to life’s struggles, she finally with the help of Jesus was able to overcome. Her faith was evidenced by her Christian fellowship with Mount Calvary Church of God In Christ, Abundant Life Community Church and, finally, True Worshippers Church of God In Christ under the pastorate of Elder Melvin Thompson and Co-Pastor, Gloria Thompson.
