



## Mother Julia Brown Morrison

Mother Julia Brown Morrison was born in Davis, North Carolina, on March 25, 1922, to her parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Timothy Brown.

Early in her childhood, the family moved to Statesville, NC. She attended the Baptist Church where she was a full-time member working for God. Later in life, she moved to Harrisburg, PA. She then joined the St. Mark Baptist Church pastored by the late Rev. Henry Williams. She wanted more of God--so she joined the Grace Church of God In Christ under the leadership of the late Elder Townsend Parker and the late Mother Parker. Thereafter, she joined the Mt. Zion Church of God In Christ under the leadership of the late Elder Ceasar Bennett where she was yet a faithful member under the leadership of Elder Reginald Frison. Mother Morrison served as a Sunday School Teacher, member of the Mother’s Board, Usher and worked on or with every Auxiliary in the church. In the District, she was President of the Mother’s Board, member of the Hospitality Committee and an Usher. She was an all-around Saint of God. If she could get there, Mother could always be found in Prayer Meetings and her favorite song was “Can’t Nobody Do Me Like Jesus.” She was well known for her cakes, pies, cookies and sharing fruit at the District Meetings. If

you wanted apples or bananas, she made sure they were there.

In Harrisburg, PA, in her ninety-fourth year, on Friday, September 16, 2016, the angels came to escort Mother Morrison safely into the Arms of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Along with her parents, she was also preceded in death by her husband of over fifty years, James Morrison; brothers, Guss Brown, Edward Brown, Clarence Brown and two infant brothers; sisters, Vifia Brown-Williams, Ada Brown, Betty Brown-Williams, Ruth Brown-Johnson and Mary Brown-Arrington.

Mother Morrison is survived by six children, Bertha Jackson (Charles Sr.), Mary Frances Elliott, Carnell Brown, James Morrison Jr., Bobby Morrison and Robert Morrison. She was the grandmother of twenty-three, great grandmother of fifty-eight and great-great grandmother of twenty-five. Her legacy will also be remembered and cherished by one sister, Essie Stenson; adopted children, Michelle and Charles Davis; special friends, Leonard Smith Jr., Karla Lyles- Tennant, Shawn Gillespie, Bobbie and Precious Moffitt; cousin and lifetime friend, Marcella Weaver; her Church Family as well as a host of other relatives and friends.
