Julian J. “Jack” Jackson, Jr., was born on October 22, 1943, in Washington, D.C. and passed away peacefully at home on April 2, 2026. Born to the late Julian Jackson, Sr., and Iris C. Thomas. Jack graduated from William Penn High School in Harrisburg, PA, in 1963.

Jack was preceded in death by his father, Julian Jackson, Sr.; his mother, Iris C. Thomas; his stepfather, James J. Thomas; and his sister, Iris M. Nimmons.

After high school, Jack went on to Auto Mechanic Training School before serving in the United States Navy Seabees.
