Kathleen E. Hill, affectionately known as “Toot,” daughter of the late Samuel R. Jones and Frances McCullough Jones, was born on Friday, April 4, 1941, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Kathleen received her education through the Steelton School District. She was united in holy matrimony to Ike Hill in 1957, and their union was blessed with two sons, Donald Anthony Hill and Ike James Hill.

Kathleen was a faithful woman of God whose love for the church spanned her entire life. She was a member of McCullough Memorial Church, where she sang in the choir.
