Lee M. Nesbit Jr., son of Lee M. Nesbit Sr. and Ukawanna Williams Nesbit, was born Wednesday, July 18, 1951, in York, PA.

Lee attended William Penn Senior High School and served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War. Lee retired from Johnson Controls and was a member of Cornerstone Baptist Church, York, where he served with the Culinary and Usher Ministries. A member of Legion 127, Lee spent much of his leisure time cooking, bowling, playing tennis, volleyball, traveling, singing karaoke and listening to jazz music.

On Thursday, February 18, 2021, at sixty-nine years of age, Lee transitioned from time to eternity. Along with his parents he was also preceded in death by four siblings, Ukawanna Nesbit, Otha Mae Nesbit, James Nesbit and Warren Nesbit.
