Leonard W. Brown, son of Mrs. Sarah Brown and William D. Carter, was born February 22, 1944, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Early in life, Leonard was baptized at St. Paul's Baptist Church. He was a graduate of John Harris High School and attended Harrisburg Area Community College.
