Deacon Lewis M. Nolden Sr., son of the late Helen and Robert T. Murray and Lewis Sutton, was born Sunday, July 15, 1951, in York, PA.

A graduate of William Penn Senior High School, Class of 1969, Lewis retired as a Roll Off Driver for Republic Services after thirty-nine years of dedicated service.

In the mid-90's, Lewis began his spiritual journey at Mount Calvary Baptist Church, York. He loved his God and his church. There was nothing he would not do for his church. On December 3, 2017, Lewis was ordained as a Deacon under the leadership of Pastor Anthony D. Brown whom he dearly loved. Lewis also served unselfishly with the Trustee, Usher and Culinary Ministries.

Lewis loved sharing the goodness of the Lord, helping and encouraging others. Leisurely, he enjoyed riding his motorcycle; he loved cars; and he found joy in adding a smile or laugh to anyone's day. At sixty-eight years of age, on Saturday, March 28, 2020, while at his home in York, PA, surrounded by loving family, Lewis passed from the labors of his

journey to his eternal reward joining his parents, Helen Murray, Robert T. Murray, Lewis Sutton; brother, Larry E. Nolden aka "Toothpick;" grandsons, Lewis Nolden III, Charlie Nolden Jr.; and granddaughter, Pearl L. Nolden.
