Lloyd R. Harris Sr., son of the late Raleigh N. Harris and the late Lottie (Lester) Brady, was born Saturday, December 31, 1932, in Philadelphia, PA.

Lloyd was united in Christian fellowship with St. Paul's Missionary Baptist Church where he served as a trustee and longtime bus driver.
