Moseroy, affectionately known as “Moe,” “Mr. Moe,” and “Mose” was born Wednesday, September 22, 1954, in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, son of the late Moseroy R. Miller Sr. and the late Josie Jean Howell Miller.

His educational path included North Forsyth High School, Winston-Salem, NC, Class of 1972, and a Cum Laude Graduate of North Carolina A & T University, Greensboro, NC, Class of 1976, where he earned a B.S. Degree in Accounting.

Upon graduation from North Carolina A & T University, he moved to Harrisburg, PA, and began his career with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as an Auditor with the Auditor General Office. He retired from the Commonwealth after thirty-five years of service.

Moseroy was a former member of Paxton Lodge #16, Free and Accepted Masons of PA.
