Oluwatoyin Ayoka Newton, daughter of the late David Ibikunle Adedokun and the late Alice Adedokun, was born March 6, 1964, in ILE-IFE, Nigeria.

After high school graduation, Mrs. Newton's higher educational and career training path included Oyo State College of Education studying English for the N.C.E. Degree; completion of the one-year compulsory National Youth Service in Plateau State Nigeria; Bachelor of Arts Degree (English) at Obafemi A—UNI-ILE-IFE, Nigeria; and RN Degree, Excelsior College, Albany, NY, USA. She was an Alumna of Our Lady's Girls High School and OAU, ILE-IFE, Nigeria. Music was among her life passions.

As a member of RCCG Living Spring Harrisburg Church, she served with Women of Virtue, Susquehanna Home Fellowship and the Member/Visitor Follow-Up. She was employed by Intelycare Inc.

On Friday, July 23, 2021, while at the Carlisle Regional Hospital, Carlisle, PA, at fifty-seven years of age, Mrs. Newton transitioned from time to eternity joining her parents and two brothers, Mr. Adedokun Adedokun and Mr. Adesiji Adedokun.
