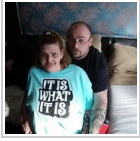
Paula was born June 4, 1969, in Harrisburg, PA, daughter of Goldie Duncan and Paul Ensminger.

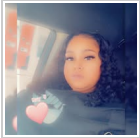
