Mr. Paulos Hannes Tucu was born on July 16, 1954 from his father the late Mr. Hannes Tucu and his mother the late Mrs. Tsehaytu Weldeghergis (Shawl) in Segeneiti, Eritrea. He was the 1st born among his siblings, Petros (twin), Kidane and Elsa.

Mr. Paulos attended elementary and middle school in Segeneiti and high school in Dekemhare. After completing his high school education, he moved to Akaki, Ethiopia and there he worked as manager of one company.

At a young age, in 1973 Mr. Paulos went on to fight for independence of Eritrea. He fought as a soldier and public relations member until 1982. In 1983, he moved to Dallas, Texas and was employed by Budweiser until 2013, holding different positions. Mr. Paulos was a loving, kind and hard-working man, known to family and friends as a generous, pure hearted, giving and humorous person.

After battling a serious illness for the last two years, on November 19, 2017, he peacefully departed this earthly life, surrounded by his family. He is survived by his daughter, 3 siblings, 5 nieces, 4 nephews and other family.
