Reid N. Poles, 89, of Middletown, passed away Saturday, October 7, 2023, at the U.P.M.C. Community Osteopathic Hospital. Born July 5, 1934, in Hume, VA, Reid was the son of the late James E. Poles and Rachel L. (Baltimore) Poles. Reid was married to the love-of-his-life, the late Patricia A. Poles for 53 years.

Reid was a graduate of the former Manassas Regional High School, Manassas, VA, Class of 1952.
