June 1, 1926 - January 24, 2012

Rosie was born in Selma, Alabama, on Tuesday, June 1, 1926, daughter of the late Earl Darling and the late Mary Shorter Darling.

At an early age, Rosie received the Lord as her Personal Savior and united with the Church of God In Christ (COGIC) in Selma. She received her formal education in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. In 1941, in Meridian, Mississippi, Rosie united in holy matrimony with Albert Lewis Sr. and from this union, four sons were born. Rosie later furthered her education at Macon College where she graduated as a Registered Nurse. She accepted employment with St. Vincent Hospital, Chicago, Illinois, and in 1988, she retired after thirty years of service.
